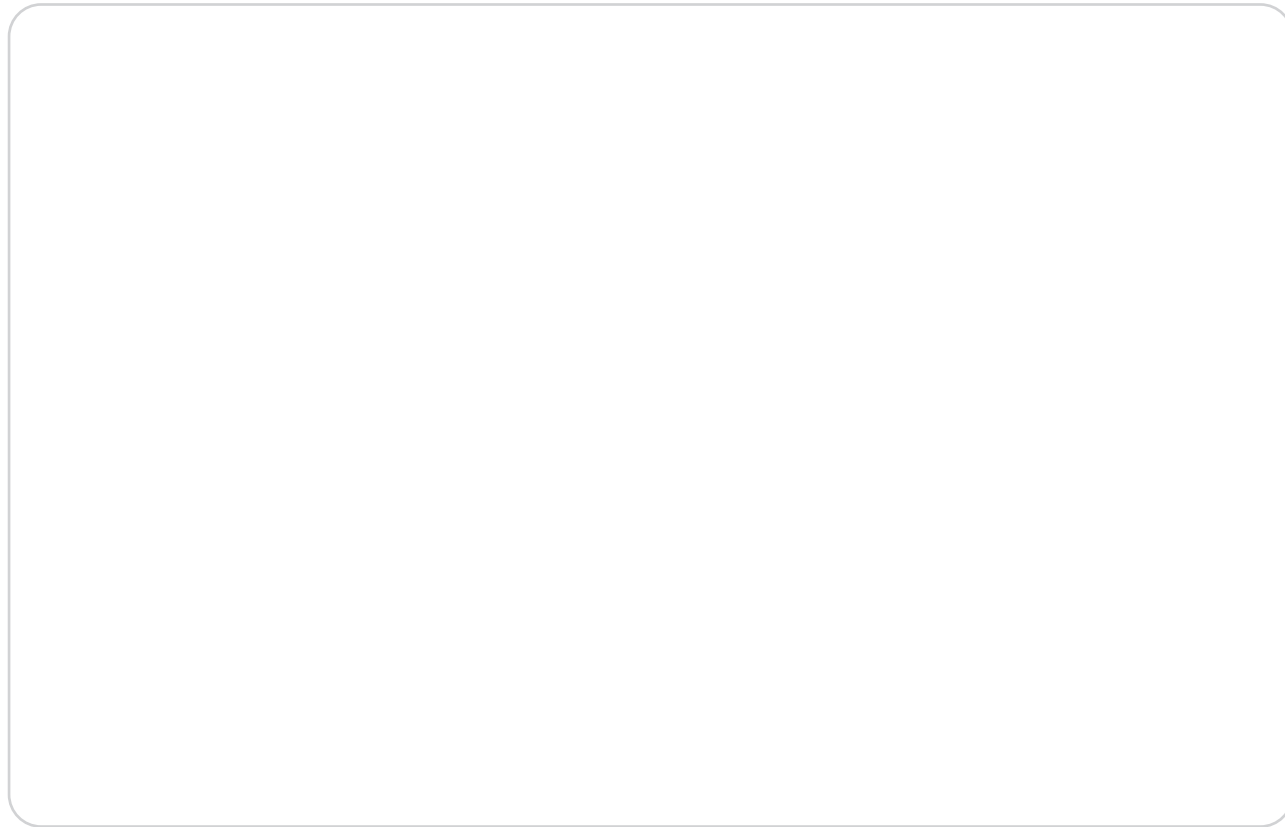

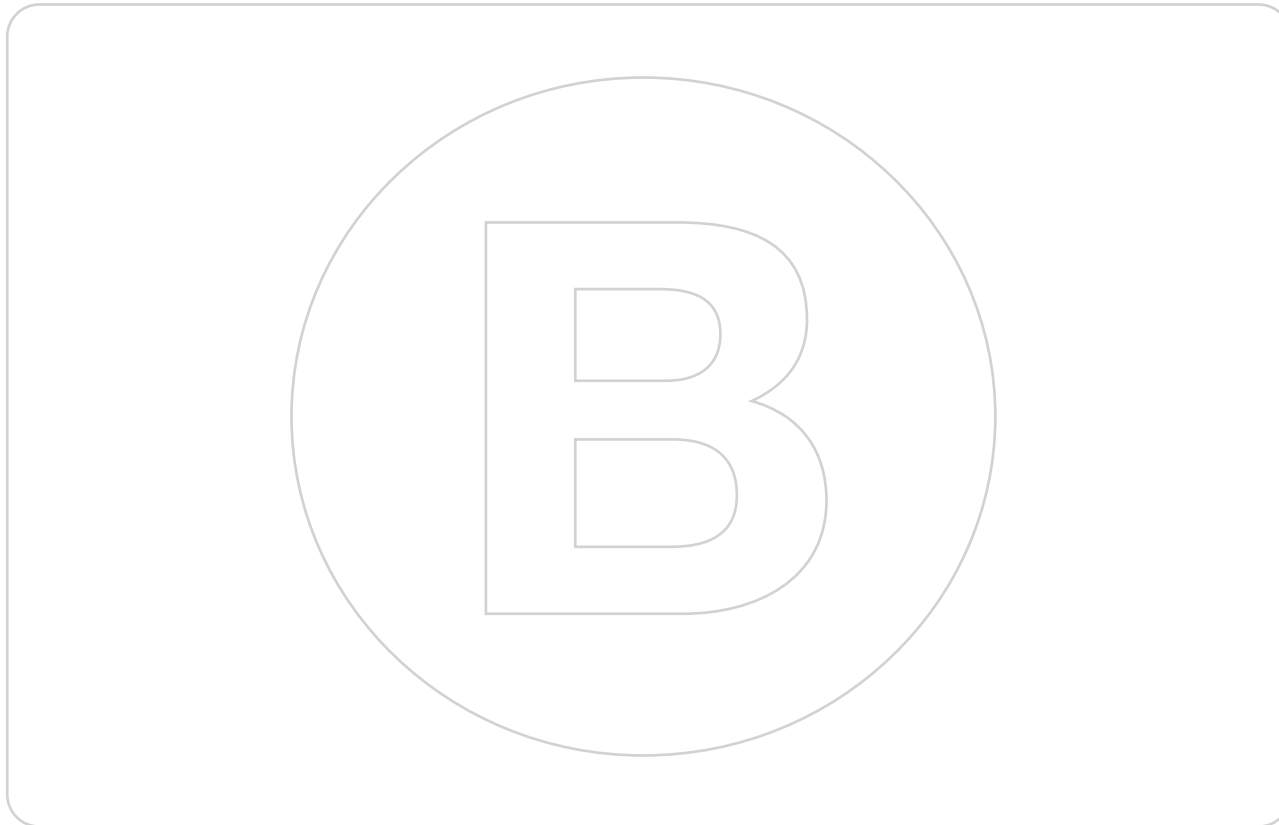
CREATIVE BASKET PROJECT - basket side 2
