#### Highlights from this year include:





Spartanburg named one of five Way to Wellville communities by HICCup. This challenge tackles 5 priorities over the next 5 years-including obesity reduction





Northside Harvest Park opened- home of the Hub City Farmers' Market and urban farm, Butterfly Foundation's Monarch Cafe, and PAL's B-Cycle station.





Healthy Schools Summit served 100 educators, administrators & community members from Spartanburg Districts 1-7 and Cherokee County.





68 childcare center directors or employees received training on physical activity and nutrition. These come from 18 centers serving 1,549 children.
